## Village Scarecrow Festival

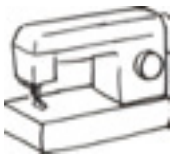


The Friends of the Library are exploring the idea of holding a Scarecrow Festival in the late summer/autumn and hope that lots of you will support us.
